## Welcome to Spring 2024 Recreational Soccer Season

Coaches/Parents/Team Managers:

Welcome to our Spring 2024 recreation season for the Oceanside Breakers. Our goal is to provide the opportunity for our children to learn and play soccer in a fun and safe environment. Oceanside Breakers has been committed to this goal for over 40 years.

We have close to 800 children participating on 68 teams. We want to remind all spectators to encourage every child to have fun and try their best. Sportsmanship is one of the most important traits we can teach. We ask that you cheer for the teams and respect the referees, players, coaches, and spectators. Negative behavior will be cause for you and/or your team's coach to be asked to leave the fields.

We continue to work closely with the City of Oceanside and the Oceanside Unified School District to use city and school facilities. Part of nurturing that relationship is care for the properties and the surrounding neighborhoods. We also have built a great relationship with the Sports Complex to be able to use the best fields in California. Please remember to pick up your trash after every game and practice. Let's leave the fields in better condition than we found them. Park only in marked spaces, properly on the streets, and do not block any driveways. Your vehicle can and will be cited and/or towed away and could cost the Club the use of the facility.

In addition, the school district and sports complex have two key rules about the use of their fields: No pets may be at games or practices, and tobacco and alcohol are not allowed. Individuals with pets will be asked to take the pet off the premises immediately. Anyone with visible tobacco products will be asked to put them away or leave.

Working together, we can all help insure we have another fun and successful season. Thanks for signing up your children to play with the Soccer Club of Oceanside.

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#### Dear Team Manager,

Thank you for volunteering your time to help make your child's season a GREAT one! This folder is designed to make your job as Team Manager (aka Team Mom or Team Dad) a lot easier and more enjoyable.

#### Below are some of the basic Team Manager's duties:

- Work closely with the Team Coach to communicate information to the players and parents.
- Make a roster for your parents. The roster should include names and phone numbers of players, parents, coach, assistant coach, and team manager. Please include your team number and team name.
- Make your team's snack schedule, (e.g., fruit and water for half time).
- Help players choose a team name.
- Purchase or make your team banner (at your team's expense), You may want to enlist the help of another parent with the responsibility of the banner at all the games and on picture day.
- Distribute team uniforms and picture day information.
- Assist on picture day by organizing the team by the scheduled time.
- Assist Coach and Club by ensuring practice and game fields are clear of trash after use.
- Pass on event information to your players and their parents.
- Plan "End of Season" party. Order player trophies and coach's gift (at your team's expense).
- Have fun!
